Postwar Transitions


Marta Verginella and Urška Strle

University of Ljubljana

The lecture will explore the transnational approach of studying women and work in the 20th-century North-Eastern Adriatic. Marta Verginella will elucidate the epistemological and structural characteristics of women's employment during the post-war transitions in this multicultural region. Meanwhile, Urška Strle will methodologically and empirically frame the position of women at the Ljubljana tobacco factory, which was managed from Vienna, Belgrade, Rome, and Ljubljana.


MARTA VERGINELLA, a professor of theory of history and the 19th history at the Department of History at the University of Ljubljana, focuses on social history, gender history, and border studies.
