## COMPARATIVE SELECTION PROCEDURE ANNOUNCEMENT N. 2019/10 FOR THE AWARDING OF N° 1 COLLABORATOR CONTRACT FOR THE RESEARCH SUPPORT ACTIVITY ENTITLED “JURIDICAL AND POLITOLOGICAL ANALYSIS OF A SPANISH CASE” IN THE FRAME OF THE PROJECT STARS STARTING GRANTS CALL 2017 “CRIMG - MAINSTREAMING OF CHILDREN’S RIGHTS: MULTILEVEL GOVERNANCE PERSPECTIVE”

According to the “Regolamento per il conferimento di incarichi individuali a soggetti esterni all’Ateneo enacted by Rector Decree n. 474/2019 of the 11.02.2019” of the University of Padova, a selection announcement has been published for the awarding of n° 1 collaborator contract for the research support activity entitled “**Juridical and politological analysis of a Spanish case**” in the frame of the Project STARS Starting Grants call 2017 “CRIMG - Mainstreaming of children’s rights: multilevel governance perspective”.

### ACTIVITY

The Collaborator must carry out the following activities:

1. Summary of previous research on Spanish case (circa 20 pages);
2. Documentary analysis of spanish laws and policies (circa 20 pages);
3. Design of the draft of questionios for the interviews (circa 1-2 pages);
4. Organisation of the interviews;
5. 20 interviews at the national and regional level in Spain;
6. Summary of the interviews and data anaysis (circa 20 pages)

on behalf of the Department of Political Science, Law and International Studies (SPGI).

The Collaborator shall present the documents concerning the results of the activity carried out as indicated in the “Activity” section to the University of Padova.

### REQUIRED SKILLS

- Knowledge of European Union policies;
- Knowledge of international regulations in the field of children rights (e.g. UNCRC);
- Knowledge of Spanish national and regional (Catalonia region) decision making processes at governmental/administrative level;
- Strong ability to use legal (e.g. case law, documentary analysis) and social science methods (e.g. conduction of interviews)
- Academic publishing experience;
- Some experience in multilevel governance/children’s rights, health, social and education sectors;
- Excellent knowledge of the English and Spanish language, fluent spoken and written;
- Good knowledge of the Italian language (in case of foreign citizens).

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Second level Degree (“Laurea Magistrale”, according to Italian D.M. 270/04) in Law (class LMG/01) or International Studies (class LM-52) or Political Science (class LM-62) or European Studies (class LM-90) or other equivalent or equipollent title by Italian law.

Should the candidate’s degree have been awarded abroad, it shall refer to a course with a duration of at least 4 years and must give access to the PhD course in the country in which it was awarded. Moreover, for

the sole purposes of this selection procedure, it must be declared to be the equivalent of an Italian Second level Degree (Specialistica/Magistrale) by a Selection Committee. Similarly, if the PhD has been awarded abroad, then it must have been conducted over a minimum of three years and, for the sole purposes of this selection procedure, must be declared to be the equivalent of an Italian PhD by a Selection Committee.
